

Access Statement for Grindon Cartshed

Introduction

We aim to cater for the needs of all visitors in our 3 bedroom accommodation. The following statement is a summary of our provision. If you have any specific questions please feel free to call us and we will endeavour to help.

Grindon Farm is supplied with water from our own maintained spring.

We look forward to welcoming you.

Pre-Arrival

- The main train station at Hexham is 20 minutes away by car. There is a small station at Haydon Bridge which is only 5 minutes away by car.
- There is a taxi service that has accessible taxis if required, we can make a booking for you.

Arrival and Car Parking Facilities

- On arrival at the property there are double entrance gates at the bottom of the track, these are open 24 hours when the accommodation is available.
- There is a parking area with enough room for 3 cars.
- The parking area is lit by an outside light with a movement sensor.
- The surface is flat and gravelled, however there is a footpath made of concrete which links with the patio.
- We can assist guests with luggage.
- The village is a five minute drive by car from the accommodation.

General Information

- Our corridor to the bedroom is 91cm wide.
- Corridors are well lit.
- The flooring on the corridor is short pile carpet.
- The covering on stairs is short pile carpet.
- Dog bowls and towels available.
- There are 2 stairs to a landing followed by a further 3 stairs to the first floor bedroom.
- The stairs are 18cm high, 26cm deep, 80cm wide.

Bedrooms

- There are 3 bedrooms, only one is M2 friendly.
- All bedrooms are en-suite and have showers.
- There are 2 stairs to a landing followed by a further 3 stairs to the first floor bedrooms.
- The stairs are 18cm high, 26cm deep, 85cm wide.
- Door widths (main and bathroom) are 80cm wide.
- One room is doubled bedded & the other two are twin bedded & these can be made into doubles.
- At least 85cm routes within the bedroom e.g. to the side of beds, between beds and dressing table, therefore allowing for left or right transfer to beds in any combination.
- Furniture is moveable on request.
- Beds heights are: Accessible room, 71cm; King sized bedroom, 64cm; Third room, 65cm.
- Beds can be raised with blocks on request.
- Television with remote control and teletext.
- Divan beds are provided.
- Two armchairs and one upright chair (no arms) can be provided in the room.
- There is an en-suite shower room (see below for details).
- Fitted short pile carpet on the floor.



Bathroom (accessible)

- Bedroom en-suite with shower.
- Door width 78cm, sliding.
- Free floor space clear of door is 140cm x 170cm.
- The wetroom has level access to shower. There is one grab rail to the right of the controls.
- The shower has an attachment and both horizontal rail on the opposite side to entry and also vertical rail to the side of the shower attachment.

- A shower seat is available.
- The basin is flat fronted. It is 82cm high.
- The toilet has left side transfer with available free space of 93cm. The toilet is 40cm high.
- There is a horizontal rail beside the toilet (opposite side to transfer) and 1 vertical rail beside the toilet cistern tank.

Grounds & Gardens

- We have a small enclosed lawned area with unrestricted views down the valley
- Hadrian's Wall is 1 mile away.
- BBQ available on request.

- Pets and service dogs welcome, please inform us when booking: 2 dogs maximum @ £20.00 per dog
- Mobile phone reception is generally good.
- We are able to use the front and back doors in the need of evacuation, the fire bell will sound continuously.
